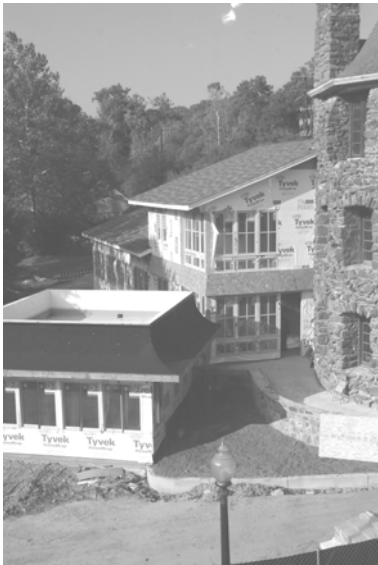

### *The Yellow Barn Virtual Art Gallery.*

With 8000 hits a week, the Yellow Barn Studio Virtual Gallery Web Site is something every member should consider. Members can display up to 15 images for one year for a fee of **\$90**. Those who are already represented on our web site can **renew their subscription for \$30 a year**, with the addition of 5 new slides at no extra cost. Any additional slides will be \$6 for each slide. Each new member can display a total of 15 images. All images must be provided, with a short biography of up to 100 words, pricelist, and transferred to CD. We can only take digitally transferable information. If you do not have the capability of scanning your own slides to a CD, we can do that for you for an additional \$40 for a maximum of 15 slides.
